PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO

This includes the copyrighted courtyard area of the museum included as part of "with paid admission." Photographs cannot be published, sold, reproduced, transferred, distributed, or otherwise commercially exploited in any manner whatsoever. The use of flash photography, tripods, and video cameras are prohibited.

Photography is not permitted in special exhibitions or areas designated as "No Photography." All photography of a non-personal nature (i.e. editorial, commercial, advertisement) is prohibited without the permission of The FMOM.

Permission to reproduce artworks, in any format, held by The FMOM must be obtained in writing from the museum office by contacting the General Manager, at penny.smith@memphistn.gov.

Inquiries for commercial and professional photography of the Fire Museum of Memphis should be made at least one month in advance. Please complete the Museum Photography/Filming Application to make an inquiry. Approval for commercial and professional photography will be made on a case by case basis.
